Mission Bay Music serves students across the County of San Diego and strives to provide students valuable performance experience and enhance the cultural experience in the music community.	\$2,691

3	Solana Center For Environmental Innovation	To support the Climate Change Panel event with the costs of staff and speaker salaries as well as development and promotional materials for the event. This panel which focuses on the firsthand accounts of the impact of climate change helps in promoting the Solana Center's mission of engaging the community to make sustainable environmental change through education and action on healthy soil, water conservation, and waste diversion.	\$3,000
