Funds will also support emergency housing with the cost of short-term rental assistance and housing navigation support including security deposits, utilities, rent subsidies and temporary shelter.</p> <p>Funds are in the public interest as these training programs and housing support will provide economic stability for members of the community.</p>	\$10,000

2	Partnership for a Better San Diego	<p>The mission of the Partnership for a Better San Diego is to combat food insecurity and promote economic stability in San Diego and Imperial Counties by empowering underserved populations.</p> <p>Funds will support the Hospitality Training Program with the costs of staff salaries, instructor stipends and supportive and facility rentals. Funds will also support the Food pantry with the cost of refrigerated truck and container rental and maintenance costs and staff salaries.</p> <p>Funds are in the public interest as these programs will create educational and job opportunities for participants as well as provide food for families in need.</p>	\$40,000
