5	San Diego Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender Pride	To support the costs of the accessibility program at the Pride festival including ASL interpretation, mobility devices, staff salaries, ramps, sensory equipment, and other accessibility technology and supplies.	\$20,000
6	University City Community Association	To support the costs of rehabbing and refurbishing the two medians with new weed barriers, native plants, and decorative rocks and boulders, replacing existing place-making signs, a small stipend for performers, supplemental lighting, a small stipend to local artists, paints and supplies, neighborhood watch signs, replacing damaged signs, replacing damaged and unusable barriers.	\$10,000

7	USS Midway Museum	To support the costs of the Veterans Day parade that honors and salutes San Diego's active duty and veteran which include the costs of a professional Parade Producer, parade insurance, San Diego Police and SDTC fees, and City permits.	\$5,000
